

GUIDELINES TO ENGLISH PRESENTATION

December 2024

TASK:

"Corporate in Culture":

- 1. Choose a cultural object (film, TV show episode(s), novel, graphic novel, short story, song...) <u>in English</u> that depicts one (or several) of the topics or sub-topics that have been discussed in *English* 5* and/or in *Leadership skills*.
- 2. Prepare an oral group presentation that describes the object, how it relates to the course topic(s), and what it says about it/them. Also include a part introducing and defining at least 3 expressions or idioms featured in the studied work.

DFTAILS:

- Who? Groups of 3 or 4 people
- When? On the day of the last class
- How long? between 10 and 15 minutes
- How?
 - Use a visual aid (powerpoint or other)
 - Make it professional yet entertaining: be creative and enthusiastic! (Golden rule: no reading!)
 - Feel free to show parts of the object (clips, extracts...), but keep them rather short (if longer than 1 minute, ask for my approval)

ASSESSMENT:

The whole **group** will receive the same grade for the quality of the content, structure and visual aid of the presentation.

Each **member** will receive an individual grade for the quality of their spoken language and body language.
