## GUIDELINES TO ENGLISH PRESENTATION N°2

### TASK:

Present a **science-fiction work** (i.e. movie, TV show, novel, short story, video game, board game...):

- Present the **work** itself (plot, author, themes)
- Describe the **technology** or technological breakthroughs that drive the plot
- Analyze what the work says about the **impact** of said technology on society and individuals
- Assess the **sustainability** of said technology

### DETAILS:

- In **pairs** or **individually**
- Where and when? In class, during the **13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> lesson**
- How long? **5 to 10 minutes**
- Part of the continuous assessment grade
- Follow the guidelines presented in class. (Golden rule: **no reading!**)

### ASSESSMENT:

- **Presentation skills:** posture, intonation, eye contact, etc.
- **Presentation structure:** introduction, signposting, conclusion
- **Visual aid** (e.g. slide show, photos, videos...) and how it is used.
- and of course, **language** (especially **pronunciation** and **intonation**)
- **Content:** **choice** of science-fiction work, **reflection** on it, use of external **sources**
- **Bibliography:** your powerpoint must contain a bibliography (last slide), follow the MLA or APA format\*
